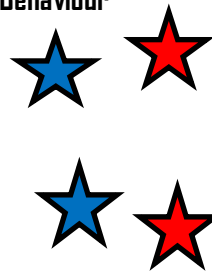

Watch the city glisten and glow as Light Night Stoke-on-Trent magnificently transforms Burslem town centre over three evenings this January.

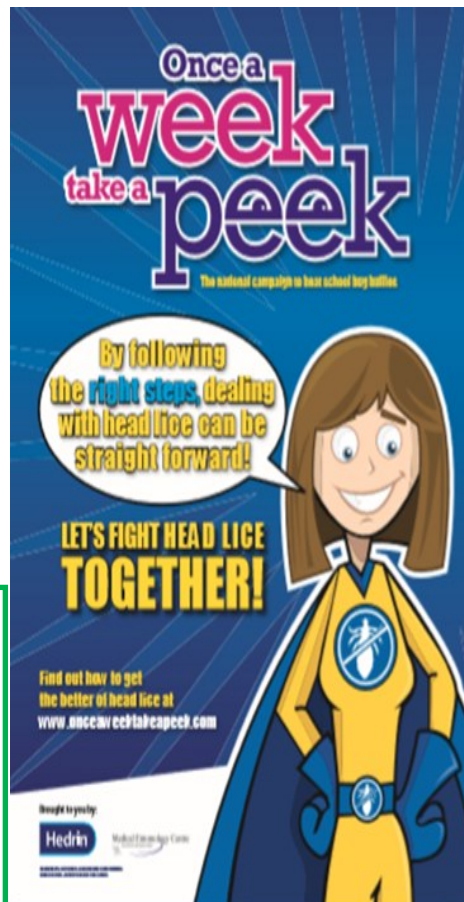
