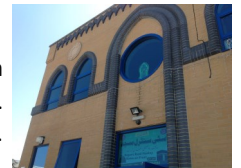
Real Life Maths Week

The children made price labels and experienced how to be a shopkeeper. In year 1 the children planned and arranged a picnic. They spent the week solving lots of problems involving money, capacity, fractions and counting. They had great fun at the picnic too. In year 2 the children got very competitive. They worked alongside Alexandra Infant School on a real life bake off. The children worked out what ingredients they needed to make cakes and how much to sell them for to make a profit. Thank you to all our parents who came to the cake sales and provided money for children to attend the ice cream shop.



On Wednesday the Y1 and Y2 pupils had a fantastic time taking part in an enrichment activity. All of the children thoroughly enjoyed taking part in laser tag. It certainly challenged their problem solving skills!!

On Thursday, Year One visited the City Central Mosque in Hanley. As part of their RE lessons, the children have been learning about the Islamic faith and this was a great opportunity to visit a place of worship. The children looked at the features of the building and had the opportunity to ask questions about it. This trip builds on from their earlier visit to a Church, enabling them to compare sacred buildings.

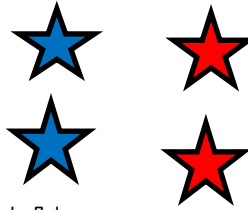

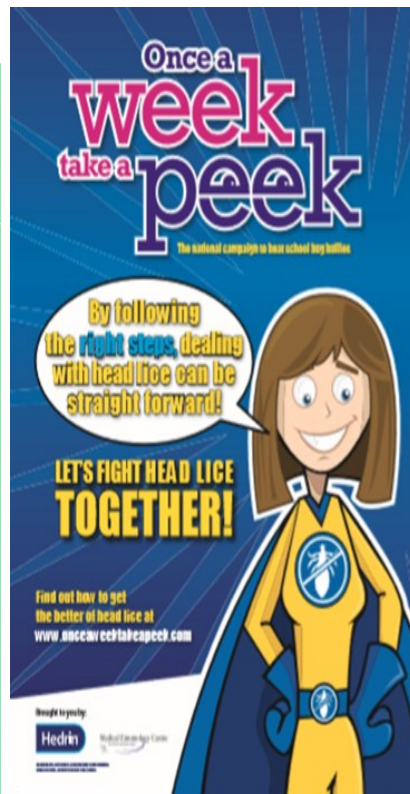
