She showed how headlights shine on fluorescent items and show up much better in the dark, so they can be seen by car drivers. Our children were able to talk about different people they knew who wore these items.

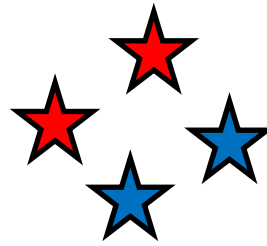
