Reading

All children will have a 'Share with me' book to read at home. These will be changed once a week in school. When reading at school children will have a different book to decode that uses the sounds they have learnt in phonics and tricky words. They will read this books 4 times a week.

This term we will be completing the topic...

Incredible Inventions

Our main focus will be Science and History.

In **History** we will research and find out about famous inventors and engineers as well as their inventions. We will look at how inventions have changed and make a timeline.

Through **Science** we will learn about the inventions/machinery and think about materials. We will look at how materials have changed over time and how this has influenced inventions. We will investigate and explore different materials.

Through **Art, Computing and Design and Technology** we will think about designing, constructing and evaluating moving objects such as vehicles.





Our **English** reading and writing will focus on non-fiction information about famous inventors and inventions. We will also read fictional stories about characters who aspire to change the world through their own inventions.



In **Maths** we will be learning to recognise the place value of each digit in a two digit number. We will partition numbers into different combinations of tens and ones. We will practice recalling number bonds to 10 and 20. This will really help us when we come to add and subtract two two digit numbers.



In **PE** we will be putting a sequence of actions together to create different dances. We will be learning to perform learnt skills with increasing control in front of others, move in time to music as well as watch others perform.



In **RE** we will be learning about Muslim beliefs about God, retelling Islamic stories and exploring objects used by Muslims.
