Dear Parents/Carers,

Stoke-on-Trent City Council recognises that life is harder for families facing increased pressure on household budgets due to the cost of living crisis. Last winter the Council received grant funding from the Government Department of Work and Pensions to provide support to families with children, other vulnerable households and individuals.

As part of this programme of support the Council are providing vouchers for families of children attending schools in the city who have benefit related free school meals and families with children who have an Education and Health Care Plan in place.

Each eligible child in the family will receive a voucher for £30 for the Easter holiday break.

Before the end of term, you will receive a link directly from Schoolvouchers.com and you will be able to select an eVoucher from a supermarket on the list. You will be able to choose from Aldi, Asda, Iceland, Morrisons, Sainsburys, or Tesco. The eVoucher code will be displayed on-screen and can be downloaded. The vouchers are issued directly from your chosen supermarket, please allow time for this to be allocated to you. If you have any queries in relation to your voucher allocation please contact your chosen supermarket. Vouchers should be issued on **Thursday, 30th March.**

If you do not have access to a phone or email, the School will be able to download your eVoucher and provide you with a printed copy.

Please contact the School office on **01782 234450**, before Friday 31st March, if you have any issues downloading your voucher as emails/telephone messages will not be responded to during the Easter holiday.

If you have a pre-payment meter and would have difficulty affording your gas/electricity this winter, please contact our partners Beat the Cold on 01782 914915, letting them know you are being supported by the Council.
